History 101

My name is Jim Coveney and I own and live on Covista Farm on County Rd. 45, about ten kilometers from Hastings. Like many local settlers, my ancestors came from County Cork, Ireland. They arrived in 1836 and first settled in Prince Edward County, then to Seymour Township, and finally to Hastings in the late 1800s. My father, Frank, was born in a log cabin on the farm in 1902. The cabin was on the old Cobourg road that ran behind the present barns. My mother, Margaret, came to Hastings from Port Dalhousie to teach in the Separate School that was located just behind the current Brett Funeral Home. Both my father and I attended the old white Cobourg Road schoolhouse on Collins Rd. next to 45. Now closed, it served our community for over 150 years. Before my retirement, I was a dairy farmer, marketing milk, purebred Holstein cattle and embryos all around the world. One of the biggest thrills in that business was when one of our cows, Covista Lindy Georgia, set a world production record in 1997. It was a rewarding career in a great location, Hastings.

Ontario's official tree is the eastern white pine. It is the tallest conifer tree in all of eastern Canada and can grow up to 40 metres (that's over 130 feet!) with the right weather and soil. This tree is easy to identify because the needles are in groups of 5 and are between 6 and 12 cm. It also has monstrous pine cones that can grow up to 20 cm long! The eastern white pine can be found throughout most of Ontario and parts of Quebec as well as parts of the US. In the days of tall ships, eastern white pines were used for the masts of British Royal Navy ships and with proper conditions these wonderful trees can live up to 400 years!
