History 101

The Trent Valley Hockey League operated between 1900 and about 1955. Hastings, Norwood, Havelock, Marmora, Madoc, Tweed, Campbellford, Stirling, Frankford and Point Anne usually all had teams. Referee Bill Clapper of Hastings, had to contend with lots of fights.

The league hosted several elite players; starting with; Joe Doherty of Norwood and Joe Powers of Hastings, dominated in the early 1950s. Before that, Hastings' Dit Clapper played for a while but in 1927 moved on to the Boston Bruins and a Hall of Fame NHL career. On his heels came Havelock's Doug Brenan, who between 1931 and 1933 played for the New York Rangers, where he also won a Stanley Cup. Then later Bobby Hull played alongside his Father for Point Anne.

Other TVL competitors of distinction were: Doug Free of Campbellford, who in 1949 won a Silver Medal at the World Championships in Sweden while Hastings ace, Murray Fife moved to Barrie Flyers juniors and then a successful coaching career in Europe. Gus Leonard of Marmora and Monty Montgomery of Lakefield, both stood out along with Hastings' Jimmy Morrow, who lead our local TVL entry for several more years. By the mid-1950s, the league sadly folded.
