History 101


Coughlan Island is the first island west of Hastings on the Trent River. The first Hastings wooden bridge was built from the north shore across the Trent to this island, and then a short span to the south shore. Close by has always been a great natural spring and water source for generations. It still offers water from a pipe extended to the shore. This island is at the head of the Percy Portage, a trail used initially by First Nations people to avoid the rapids of the Trent River.

The charming island house was built in 1904 by Dr. Richard Coughlan. Sadly, he died before completing it. The McGuire family bought it in 1928 and they finished the structure and landscaping. It is still owned by members of the McGuire family, Gail and Bob Brown. An autumn colour photo of the island is on the back cover of the Hastings Historical Society's new photo book.

Animal Crackers

A typical gorilla father is in charge of a clan as large as 30 gorillas. He is responsible for finding food for his group, which is a big job seeing as gorillas typically eat up to 50 pounds of food per day! He is quite respectful of the mother of his children, always dining with her first before letting the kids join in on the meal. A gorilla dad is also very attentive, fending off threats by fiercely beating his chest and charging enemies. He often has to fight off other male gorillas who are known to kill baby gorillas when trying to take over the group. He spends a good deal of time with their young until they become teenagers, playing lovingly with his offspring and settling any arguments that arise between siblings.
