The Victoria Day long weekend is extra special, in Hastings, because it means cottages open and tourists return to our picturesque village. It is also the weekend that pickerel fishing opens! We are very fortunate to have a spawning bed located in the center of our community! Each spring hundreds of fish travel the Trent Severn waterway to lay/ fertilize eggs and (hopefully) ensure the continuation of fishing in Hastings. Numerous species navigate the rough waters and find safety in the rock filled bed located beside Banjo's Grill. It's amazing to take a walk on a sunny day and watch the fish swim past the old concrete wall east of the bridge and travel the path under the bridge to rest in the water by Banjo's. Spawning beds are essential to the continuation of fishing and should never be disturbed by overly excited anglers. Visit the bed and watch some amazing species!

History 101

THE OLDEST RESIDENT

Mr. Timothy Coughlan moved to Crooks' Rapids, in 1837, and became the first official resident! He worked for James Crooks clearing land to prepare for the dam and lock construction, and helped two other men to dig a channel on the south side of the river (currently the spawning bed). Timothy was instrumental in the development of early Hastings, and in 1844 all his hard work paid off when he was awarded the position of lock master. He got married in 1845, fathered 6 children, and held the title of lock master for almost 50 years! He was also the first Reeve and held the position until 1877. Old Mr. Coughlan died in 1894 and was temporarily buried at a cemetery in Asphodel. He was moved to his final resting place, at Mt. Carmel cemetery, when it opened just before the turn of the century.
